“Westwood’s 2017 Pinot Noir is farmed from 4 rows in the Annadel Gap Vineyard. It is expressive right out of the gate, with scents of ripe dark berries, plum, raspberry, currant, and cherry, along with dried leaf, dried spice and lavender. On the palate this is focused, with flavors of ripe berries, dark chocolate and red currants, along with hints of blood orange and herbs that continue to linger on the supple finish. Drink over the next 5-8 years.”
