Tasting Notes

Elegant and richly textured flavors of dark fruit and Asian spice. Rich acidity and polished tannins leading to a finish that shows sage, herbs and black olives.

Vineyard

From warm sunny days, to cooler fog covered evenings, Sonoma County's geography and climate influences each vineyard. The grapes for this Pinot Noir were selected primarily from the floor of the Sonoma Valley where unique terroir provides varied soils and ideal growing conditions.

Winemaking

Each Pinot Noir clone from the separate vineyards were hand-harvested at night, hand-sorted, then tank fermented in open-top stainless steel and oak uprights. Averaging 10% whole clusters, the wine remained on skins for 18 days, then basket pressed and aged in French oak barrels for a total of 16 months – approx. 25% new oak, 75% 2-3 years old oak.
